Immediately the boy's father cried out and said, "I do believe; help my unbelief." Mark 9:24


I don't know about you, but this verse can define my life at times. I don't want to admit this; instead it would be easier to brag on my faith, to tell others how much I believe. But there are many times when I am praying, "Help my unbelief." Ever since his son was little, the daddy in this story faced the unknown and the horrible every single day. His son was possessed by a spirit, causing convulsions, foaming at the mouth, and much worse. For years and years, his son's life—and his—was one of anguish and torment. Yet, this man had enough faith to go look for Jesus. And when he didn't immediately find Jesus, he found the disciples and asked for their assistance. As we know, the disciples were unable to help. But when Jesus showed up, the father asked Jesus to come to his side.

Actually, the word "help" comes from a Greek root word meaning, "To rally." To draw a picture, the father is using a word that a soldier might use in battle as he sees a breach in the line of defense and says, "Rally here!" For the father, this is warfare. He needs Jesus to rush to his side, so he says, "Help my unbelief." I'm thankful for this man's honesty and transparency. Instead of simply going through the motions of prayer (as I can certainly do), this man cries out. Does he believe? Certainly, or he would have never sought out Jesus. And yet this father is willing to publicly admit that he needs more faith. He needs help; the kind only Jesus can give.

There were two miracles on this day. The first is obvious; a boy received healing from a terrible spirit. He got his life back. We can all be sure that this was a day he would never forget. But there was a second miracle the father possibly never imagined. This father came to Jesus on behalf of his son, and received his own gift; the gift of a new depth of believing.

After reading this story I ask, "Do I believe in Jesus with so much abandon that no matter the circumstances I see, no matter the future I face; I will believe and trust in him?" That's what this father received; we can, too. Today I do not have that answer for certain. I want to say I will always trust with all that is in me, of course. And yet I want to be like this father and be honest enough to say, "I believe; help my unbelief." Because when I ask Jesus to help me, to rally to my side and take my belief deeper than I could ever imagine, I know Jesus will answer clearly, "I will."
