From the Director



A big game-changer, the *Dobbs* ruling that overturned *Roe*, has opened an opportunity for "the game" to be played in new and different ways.

Of course, Big Abortion (and their friends at Big Tech) are working hard to change the game in their favor. They've already secured the relaxing of FDA rules to allow for more abortion pills to be accessed with less oversight. The abortion industry is brushing aside any remaining pro-life legislation in *Abortion* States as well as actively litigating against laws in *Life* States that protect their smallest residents. Big Abortion sees this post-*Roe* era as a way to get their ideology of "abortion anytime, anywhere, for any reason," codified in state constitutions.

And Big Tech is right there with them. Google's actions (from 2018) to introduce disclaimers on PHC ads, "Does not provide abortions," echoes from a battle over a Yellow Pages listing decades ago.

Yet, the history of pregnancy help has involved many innovations over the years in services, marketing, and branding. Even while keeping the main thing, the main thing: loving, valuing, and supporting those at risk for abortion so they could make a life-affirming decision about their pregnancy and future. Over the years we learned new tools, introduced new techniques, and identified various tips that helped us reach and rescue lives threatened by the permanency of abortion.

In a similar way, the New Testament church leaders listened intently to the guidance of the Holy Spirit. Some felt the call to stay and minister in Jerusalem (James) while others felt the call to take the Gospel into the "remotest parts of the earth," (Acts 1:8) like Apostle Paul. Same mission, yet different communities, differing methods (1 Cor. 9:21), and varied messaging (remember Paul preached about "the Unknown God" in Acts 17).

Whether they stayed under the threat of persecution or were dispersed into far lands; whether they preached in the public square or taught in the synagogue; whether they were obvious in their presentation or more adaptive to the culture; they were all game-changers in the communities that received them. They were game-changers even while the culture around them was full of skeptics or active idol worshipers openly hostile to the missionaries and their message of life.

And this is the very environment we are in today in the mission field created by abortion. Skeptics abound who judge our good work just because it is motivated by our faith in the Giver of Life. Abortion proponents, essentially worshipers of Molech (Lev. 18:21), are openly hostile to us, peaceful pregnancy help missionaries, who serve the Giver of Life.
