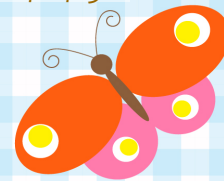

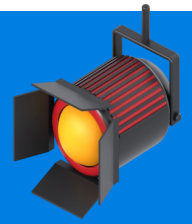

Ramona Women's Clinic – "Moms in College" Scholarship
